

Personnel Transfer Procedure Poster

**WHEN YOU SEE THE FOLLOWING LIGHTS DISPLAYED ON THE CTV
FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS**



STOP

**Remain where you are &
DO NOT move.
It is NOT safe to board or
disembark the ship or vessel.**

PREPARE

**Remain in a safe place &
DO NOT move.
Get ready to board or
disembark the ship or vessel.**

GO

**DO NOT RUN.
A crew member will give you
instructions & assist you in
the vessel transfer process.**

DISSEMBARKING A PACIFIC TUG VESSEL

Before disembarking a Pacific Tug vessel, it is the responsibility of the Master (or delegate) to clearly communicate the TRAFFIC LIGHT transfer process to each transferring person & appoint a dedicated crew member to direct & assist the transfer of each person.

BOARDING A PACIFIC TUG VESSEL

Before boarding a Pacific Tug vessel, it is the responsibility of the Ship's Captain (or delegate) to clearly communicate the TRAFFIC LIGHT transfer process to each transferring person & to follow the directions of the Pacific Tug crew.

POSITIVE COMMUNICATIONS

Before the transfer process can proceed, the Ship's Captain must confirm with the Pacific Tug Master, that each transferring person is aware of the TRAFFIC LIGHT transfer process & the person is able to safely complete then activity. The activity will only proceed at the direction of the Pacific Mug Master.
